Preparations for the 30. International Theatre Festival Divadelná Nitra continue

Who selects Slovak productions for the main programme of our 30. festival edition?

This year's main festival programme was selected by theatre scholar and critic Karol Mišovic. He focused primarily on the current edition's festival theme:

TRANSCENDENCIES, approaching it from various points of view. The selection was also strongly influenced by the pandemic, as many productions could only be viewed online, which often resulted in a wholly different experience. Nonetheless, his choice of productions is diverse both in genre and theme. He did not limit himself to new productions but also reached for older works rehearsed before the outbreak of COVID-19. In case the pandemic situation does not change dramatically, spectators will be able to see all Slovak productions live.



How are foreign productions selected for the 30. ITF Divadelná Nitra?

The foreign programme section of the 30. International Theatre Festival Divadelná Nitra is curated by theatre scholars Martina Vannayová and Ján Šimko. Given the difficult situation worldwide caused by the pandemic, festival curators decided to move the foreign programme section partly online and also to show videos of productions in the hall. Nevertheless, the event's organisers greatly care to feature foreign productions in the best quality possible, although video recording. This is why they have chosen foreign productions so exceptional by their artistic quality and video recording that they do not detract from the spectator's experience at all. Importantly, foreign productions will be screened in theatre halls equipped with an excellent sound system and projection so there certainly is much to look forward to.



What is the accompanying programme for the 30. International Theatre Festival Divadelná Nitra?

The accompanying programme is an inseparable part of our festival. This year, too, visitors can look forward to concerts in the square, children's theatre, two stand-up evenings, workshops, discussions and many other activities throughout the festival. The line-up will mostly feature Slovak bands and artists, as we want to limit the chance of having to cancel our programme in case the pandemic situation takes a turn for the worse. We are also very excited about planned collaborations with the organisers of other events in Nitra taking place during the festival.



Transcending Divadelná Nitra 1992 – 2021

One special project planned for the 30. International Theatre Festival Divadelná Nitra is the publication of *Transcending Divadelná Nitra 1992 – 2021*. Through a series of essays, analyses, academic studies, an interview and a host of photographs, the book will offer a complex survey of the festival's thirty years of existence.

The volume is scheduled for publication in early 2022, but you can already look forward to a theory-focused event and discussion with its contributors during the festival in October 2021, co-organised by The Theatre Institute. Editors Romana Štorková Maliti and Martina Vannayová and festival director Darina Kárová hosted a discussion with a part of the authors' collective.
